



Vocabulary: Adding on the Number Line



Vocabulary

- Addend – a number that is added.
 - For example, in the sum $5 + 3 = 8$, “5” and “3” are addends.
- Commutative property of addition – a rule that states that changing the order of numbers that are added does not change the sum.
 - For example, $5 + 3$ and $3 + 5$ are both equal to the same value, 8.
- Sum – the result of adding numbers.
 - For example, the sum of 5 and 3 is 8 because $5 + 3 = 8$.
