## Vocabulary: Adding on the Number Line

## Vocabulary

- Addend - a number that is added.
- For example, in the sum $5+3=8$, " 5 " and " 3 " are addends.
- Commutative property of addition - a rule that states that changing the order of numbers that are added does not change the sum.
- For example, $5+3$ and $3+5$ are both equal to the same value, 8 .
- Sum - the result of adding numbers.
- For example, the sum of 5 and 3 is 8 because $5+3=8$.
