

Vocabulary: Adding on the Number Line

Vocabulary

- Addend a number that is added.
 - \circ For example, in the sum 5 + 3 = 8, "5" and "3" are addends.
- <u>Commutative property of addition</u> a rule that states that changing the order of numbers that are added does not change the sum.
 - o For example, 5 + 3 and 3 + 5 are both equal to the same value, 8.
- <u>Sum</u> the result of adding numbers.
 - \circ For example, the sum of 5 and 3 is 8 because 5 + 3 = 8.
