## Vocabulary

- Expression - a combination of numbers, variables, and/or operations.
- For example, $x-2,8 m, r \div 6,7,3 x+4$, and $\left(2+\left(\frac{5}{11}\right)^{2}-0.3\right)$ are all expressions.
- Variable - a letter used to represent an unknown number.
- For example, in the expression $w+9, w$ is the variable.
