## Vocabulary

- Approximate not exact or completely accurate.
  - For example: "The approximate population of the United States is 300 million."
    There are about 300 million people living in the United States, but there aren't exactly 300 million.
  - The word "approximate" can also be used as a verb: "She couldn't make the measurements exactly, so she approximated them."
- <u>Estimate</u> a rough calculation or best guess.
  - A good estimate is reasonably close to the exact answer.
  - Estimates are useful for making quick calculations in your head.
  - The word "estimate" can also be used as a verb: "He estimated that it would take one hour to finish his homework."
