

Vocabulary: Coastal Winds and Clouds

Vocabulary

- Condensation change from a gas to a liquid.
 - o Condensation of water occurs when water vapor is cooled.
 - Condensation forms clouds, mist, and fog.
- Convection transfer of heat through movement of a fluid.
- <u>Convection current</u> the circular motion of a fluid (such as air) in which hot material rises while cold material sinks.
 - o Hot fluid rises because it is less dense than cold fluid.
 - As hot fluid rises, cold fluid rushes in to occupy the space.
- <u>Land breeze</u> a wind that blows from the land to the sea.
 - A land breeze is also known as an offshore breeze.
- Sea breeze a wind that blows from the sea to the land.
 - o A sea breeze is also known as an onshore breeze.



Convection currents
