- The 24 -hour clock is also known as "military time."
- To convert to the 24-hour clock, add 12 hours to all PM times starting at 1:00 PM.
- For example, on the 24 -hour clock, 4:30 PM is called 16:30.
- Analog clock - a clock that uses angles to indicate time.
- Most analog clocks have "hands" that move around a round clock face to show the current hour and minute. Many also have a third hand for seconds.
- Standard wall clocks, such as the ones shown in the Elapsed Time Gizmo ${ }^{\text {TM }}$, are analog clocks. Digital clocks are not analog.


Analog clock

- Elapsed time - the time that passes between two events.
- For example, the elapsed time between 1:30 PM and 5:30 PM is 4 hours.
