Vocabulary

- <u>Controlled experiment</u> a fair test of a hypothesis.
 - Generally, in a controlled experiment, all conditions are kept the same except for the variable being tested.
- <u>Germination</u> the initial growth of a plant from a seed; sprouting.
- <u>Hypothesis</u> a tentative explanation which can be tested by doing experiments.
- Seed a small, usually hard structure that contains the embryo of a plant.
- <u>Sprout</u> the young start of a plant (noun); to begin to grow (verb).
- <u>Variable</u> a factor that can be changed in an experiment.
