- <u>Absorb</u> to take in.
 - When light is absorbed by a substance, it is neither reflected nor transmitted through the substance.
- <u>Greenhouse</u> a structure made mainly of glass that is used for growing plants.
 - Light can get into a greenhouse, but the heated air inside cannot escape.
- <u>Radiation</u> energy that is transmitted through space.
 - Forms of radiation include visible light, gamma rays, x-rays, ultraviolet light, infrared waves, microwaves, and radio waves.
- <u>Reflect</u> to bounce back from a surface.
- <u>Thermal energy</u> energy that comes from the movement of tiny particles.
 - o As an object heats up its particles move faster and its thermal energy increases.
