## Vocabulary: Inscribed Angles

## Vocabulary

- $\quad$ Arc - a part of a circle between two points on the circle.
- For example, $\overparen{B C}$ is an arc of the circle shown to the right.
- Central angle - an angle with a vertex at the center of a circle.
- For example, $\angle B A C$ is a central angle of the circle shown to the right.

- Chord - a segment whose endpoints lie on a circle.
- For example, $\overline{B D}$ and $\overline{C D}$ are chords of the circle shown above.
- Circle - the set of all points that are the same distance from a given point.
- A circle is named by its center.
- For example, circle $A$ is shown above.
- Inscribed angle - an angle with a vertex that lies on a circle and sides that contain chords of the circle.
- For example, $\angle B D C$ is an inscribed angle of the circle shown above.
