Vocabulary: Phases of the Moon

💋 Vocabulary

- <u>Axis</u> a line connecting the North Pole to the South Pole.
- <u>Crescent</u> Moon phase in which less than half of the Moon appears to be illuminated.
- <u>First Quarter</u> Moon phase in which exactly half of the Moon appears to be illuminated (occurs when the Moon has gone one quarter of the way around Earth).
- <u>Full Moon</u> Moon phase in which all of the Moon appears to be illuminated.
- <u>Gibbous</u> Moon phase in which more than half of the Moon appears to be illuminated.
- <u>Illuminate</u> to brighten with light.
- <u>New Moon</u> Moon phase in which none of the Moon appears to be illuminated.
- <u>Orbit</u> the path of a celestial body (such as a moon or a planet) around a larger celestial body.
- <u>Revolve</u> to move around a central point.
- <u>Rotate</u> to spin on an axis.
- <u>Third Quarter</u> Moon phase in which exactly half of the Moon appears to be illuminated (occurs when the Moon has gone three quarters of the way around Earth).
- <u>Waning</u> decreasing in size.
- <u>Waxing</u> increasing in size.
