Vocabulary

- <u>Error</u> the difference between an estimated, measured, or observed value and the true value.
 - The formula for error is: error = estimated value actual value
 - For example, if the true value is 51% and the estimated value is 54%, the error is 3%.
- Poll a survey of people to determine their information, opinions, or expected votes.
- <u>Population</u> an entire group of objects or individuals.
- <u>Sample</u> a part of a population selected to represent the entire population.
