

Vocabulary: Reverse the Field

Vocabulary

- Inversion a reversal of position, location, or relationship.
 - Three inversions are explored in the Reverse the Field Gizmo™: up-down, leftright, and up-down-left-right.
- Mean the sum of a set of numbers divided by the number of items in the set.
 - o The mean of a set of numbers is also known as the set's average.
 - o For example, the mean of 4, 4, 5, 7, and 10 is $\frac{4+4+5+7+10}{5} = \frac{30}{5} = 6$.
- Retina a light-sensitive membrane that covers the back of the eye.
 - Light is focused by the *lens* of the eye to form an image on the retina.
 - The image on the retina is upside-down and reversed.
 - Light is detected by rod and cone cells in the retina. Nerve impulses are then transmitted to the brain via the optic nerve.
