

## Vocabulary: Spin the Big Wheel!

## Vocabulary

- Certain definite.
  - o If an outcome is certain, it will happen every time.
- Impossible unable to occur.
  - o If an outcome is impossible, it can never happen.
- Outcome a possible result of a trial.
- <u>Probability</u> a number between zero and one that states how likely an outcome is.
  - A probability of 0 means that the event is impossible.
  - A probability of 1 means that the event is certain.
  - o A probability of  $\frac{2}{3}$  means that the event will occur about 2 out of every 3 trials.
- <u>Sample space</u> the set of all possible outcomes of a trial.
  - For example, if you are flipping a coin, the sample space has two outcomes: "heads" or "tails."
- <u>Trial</u> a test of something, an experiment.
  - o For example, a trial could be flipping a coin once or spinning a wheel once.
  - o In general, the more trials you do, the more reliable your results will be.
