



Vocabulary: Target Sum Card Game



Vocabulary

- Difference – the result of subtracting numbers.
 - The difference between 8 and 3 is 5 because $8 - 3 = 5$.
- Digit – a single numeral that may be part of a larger number.
 - For example, the digits in the number 32 are 3 and 2.
- Place value – the value of a digit based on its position in a number.
 - For example, in the number 1,234 the 1 is in the thousands place, so it represents 1 thousand or 1,000. The 2 is in the hundreds place, so it represents 2 hundreds or 200. The 3 represents 3 tens or 30, and the 4 represents 4 ones or 4.
 - In terms of a sum, $1,234 = 1,000 + 200 + 30 + 4$.
- Sum – the result of adding numbers.
 - The sum of 7 and 4 is 11 because $7 + 4 = 11$.
