



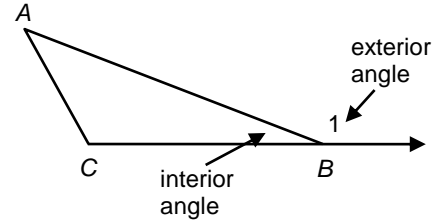
Vocabulary: Triangle Angle Sum



Vocabulary

- Exterior angle – an angle formed by one side of a polygon and the extension of an adjacent side.

- For example, $\angle 1$ is an exterior angle of $\triangle ABC$ shown to the right.



- Interior angle – an angle formed by two sides of a polygon that share an endpoint.

- For example, the interior angles of $\triangle ABC$ above are $\angle ABC$, $\angle BCA$, and $\angle CAB$.

- Triangle – a polygon with three sides.
