



Vocabulary: Modeling and Solving Two-Step Equations



Vocabulary

- Equation – a mathematical sentence that states that two expressions are equal.
 - The two equal expressions in an equation are written with an *equals sign* (=) between them.
- Solution – a value or values that make an equation or inequality true.
 - For example, 1 is the solution of the equation $3x + 4 = 7$ because it makes the equation true: $3(1) + 4 = 7$.
- Solve – to find the solution to an equation or inequality.
