- <u>Descriptive investigation</u> an investigation in which a scientist observes and measures objects in nature without interfering in any natural processes.
- Gravity the force of attraction between any two objects in the universe.
- <u>High tide</u> the maximum height reached by a rising tide.
 - o "High tide" can also refer to the time at which high tide occurs.
- <u>Low tide</u> the minimum height of a falling tide.
 - o "Low tide" can also refer to the time at which low tide occurs.
- <u>Tides</u> The regular rise and fall of ocean surfaces.
