## Putting Together a "Works Cited" Page

Often when you are writing a scientific paper or report, you collect information from a variety of sources. Each of these sources needs to be listed, or **cited**, in a clear and concise way that allows readers to locate the source. Sources are listed in the "Works Cited" section of your paper or report. A "Works Cited" section is sometimes also called a "Bibliography."

Different types of sources are cited in different ways, but all citations include at least the date and the author. Use the table below as a guide for citing a variety of different sources.
